10. Last but not the least - Spend your precious time with your family members and friends.





Example Story: "The Lion and the Mouse" or "The Clever Camel" or "The Thirsty Crow."






## ENGLISH NOUN

Let's enjoy learning nouns the Rajasthani way!"


### Make a Model of Noun using Cardboard and Waste Material and classify them into four categories





Reading helps us learn new words, understand stories, and become smarter.


Speaking helps us share our ideas, ask questions, and talk to friends. When we read and speak well, we become more confident and do better in school. These skills help us learn and grow every day!







If you're visiting a place like Delhi with your family, some places you can visit are:







Greater than ( $>$ ), Less than ( $<$ ), Equal to ( $=$ )

Let's Help the Hungry Crocodile!

How to Play :-

- Take two numbers or countable blocks and place them on either side of a crocodile's mouth.
- The crocodile always opens its mouth toward the bigger number – because he's greedy!

Example:  $5 > 3$  (The mouth opens toward 5)

- If both sides have the same number, use the " $=$ " symbol instead.


Why It's Fun:

Because the crocodile loves eating big numbers—and you'll become a number comparison expert while feeding him!



